

Summary of Modeling WG Meeting (#8)
Tuesday, Nov. 9

- 1) DOE will accept requests from SSC, EIPC or EISPC on exploring available data resources from the labs. David Meyer proposed setting up a call with each of the subgroup leads and the labs to match needs with resources.
- 2) Each person will submit their request for working on one of 8 categories by tomorrow. Keystone will send 3 page description to MWG members.
 - a. Canadian model data = DOE has input on this, Steve Chui can help with part of Canada (Ontario)
 - b. Need to integrate the change in inputs over time – or some rule to scale up
 - c. May be some data needs that fall outside of the 8 categories, e.g. where are PHEVs in the template?
 - d. May need to go out 30 years to capture the impact of some of the emerging technologies. To avoid “horizon problem” associated with capital intensive technologies. MWG is the appropriate group to make that recommendation if necessary.

- 4) Proposed transmission expansion sensitivity proposed by EIPC – no additional input.
